It is at the discretion of the competition co-chairs whether to accept late entries, which will be assessed a \$15.00 late fee.

Sanction: Sanctioned #C-36485 from the US Figure Skating by the Shaker Figure Skating Club.

Fees: \$65.00 per skater for first event; \$15.00 per skater for 2nd event; and \$10.00 per skater for 3rd event. Each skater may participate in a maximum of three (3) events (excluding "That's Entertainment" Group Event). Make checks and money orders payable to Shaker FSC (no cash please). Checks returned for non-sufficient funds and contested credit card charges will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. Payment of the fee will be required before skater is allowed to participate in practice ice or events.

Entry Form: **ONLINE ENTRY PREFERRED:** Online entry with secure credit card payment is available at www.shakerfsc.org. Online entry must be completed by midnight on December 15, 2011.*

*Individual entries will be accepted online for Freeskate, Short Program/Compulsory, Showcase, Maneuver and Spin Team Events. The High School Affiliated (HSAC) Team Contact must register the team online for the "That's Entertainment" Group Event (which has a separate fee).

For paper entries, the High School Affiliated Club (HSAC) Team Contact must fill out the actual application and a \$20.00 surcharge per application will be charged. No individual applications will be accepted.

You may submit your entries prior to receiving your HSAC approval (see rule 2 below). Once received from US Figure Skating, the HSAC certificate must be sent to Emily Davidson.

Rules: 1. This competition is a Special Competition, as defined in rule 3200 of the Official 2012 US Figure Skating Rulebook. As such, this Announcement will take precedence when there is a conflict with US Figure Skating Competition Rules or Skating Standard Regulations.



2. Eligible persons who are members in good standing of a High School Affiliated Club (HSAC) of the US Figure Skating may compete. High School Club membership must be renewed annually through US Figure Skating by the HSAC Team Advisor. ("How to Form a High School Affiliated Club" and the HSAC Application can be found at www.shakerfsc.org.)
3. All skaters must be members in good standing of US Figure Skating.
4. Competitors must currently be enrolled in and attend as full time students the public or private high school (or feeder school – see Rule 5) they represent or be home schooled and live in Ohio. Competitors may not represent more than ONE high school team.
5. Teams must consist of at least two competitors from a HSAC. At least one competitor must be in grades 9-12. High school teams may recruit 5th – 8th grade students of the feeder school(s) to that high school. (Written documentation of the feeder relationship must be included with the application.) For example, a team may consist of one high school student and multiple middle/junior high school members. Please see
6. The competition's chair will make final approval of a team's membership.
7. Team members may include both ladies and men.
8. Competitors may skate up one freeskate test level in any event.
9. There will be no age limit on any event except Juvenile.
10. There is a limit of three individual/team events per skater.
11. During the competition, team members or their Team Advisor may be at the boards but PRIVATE COACHES ARE NOT PERMITTED RINKSIDE/AT THE BOARDS.
12. For Free Skate events only, a competitor who won the event in the prior year may not compete at the same level (excepting senior).

Test Level: Registered US Figure Skating freeskate test level as of December 15, 2011.

Music: CD's only. Bring two. Mark with the skater's name/event. All CD's must be turned in at registration.

Schedule: Competition schedules will be emailed and posted the web at: www.shakerfsc.org as soon as possible after the deadline. To receive a schedule you must provide your email address. Schedules will also be posted on the Greater Cleveland Council website.

Refunds: Full refunds, minus a processing fee of 3.5%, are available if withdrawal is prior to December 15, 2011. After December 15, 2011, entry refunds are only available if the competition is not held or there is a death in the competitor's immediate family. There will be NO medical refunds given. Please contact Emily Davidson (216.295.2020 / eod@wowway.com) for refund information. If you register online, the processing fee is not refundable for any reason.

Admission: No admission will be charged.

Final Rounds: All events are final rounds.

Judging: The 6.0 judging system will be used for all events.



Scoring: Individual team members acquire points accumulated to determine team placements. Points to be awarded are 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd, 4 points for 3rd, 3 points for 4th, 2 points for 5th, and 1 point for 6th. Points earned are reduced to the number of skaters/teams entered if less than six skaters or teams compete in an event. Tied placements earn full points for that placement.

- Awards:**
1. Individual medals will be awarded to skaters for 1st through 6th place in each event.
 2. Plaques will be awarded to the 1st place team in each type of event (free skating, short program/compulsory moves, artistic showcase, spins, and maneuver team)
 3. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophies will be awarded to the teams with the most accumulated points for all events combined.
 4. Team Spirit Award will go to the team receiving the most votes from the judges.

Practice Ice: Practice ice may be available at Thornton Park Ice Arena the mornings of the events. A practice ice schedule, if available, will be posted with the schedule.

Videos/Photos: Action Photos and Video will be available from ProEventPhoto. ProEventPhoto also plans to live stream this event at ProEventPhoto.com.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries, eliminate events due to insufficient entries, and combine or divide groups as necessary.

DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS

Each HSAC team member may enter up to a maximum of three (3) individual and/or team events.

SINGLES FREE SKATE		
<i>There is no limit to the number of skaters a high school team may enter in this event. The event will be judged according to the well balanced program requirements in the latest US Figure Skating Rule Book. Skaters may skate at their highest Free Skate level passed or one level higher. Juvenile and Open Juvenile and/or Ladies and Men may be combined at the discretion of the referee depending on number of entries. All times are plus or minus 10 seconds.</i>

PRE-JUVENILE	2 min.	May <u>not</u> have passed higher than Pre-Juvenile Free Skate Test. An Axel and up to 3 different double jumps may be repeated once as individual jumps, jump sequences or jump combinations. (Rule 4250)
JUVENILE	2 min. 15 sec.	May <u>not</u> have passed higher than the Juvenile Free Skate Test. Have not reached 14 years of age as of application deadline. (Rule 4240)
OPEN JUVENILE	2 min. 15 sec.	May not have passed higher than the Juvenile Free Skate Test. Age 14 and older as of application deadline. (Rule 4240)
INTERMEDIATE	2 min. 30 sec.	May <u>not</u> have passed higher than the Intermediate Free Skate Test. (Rule 4230)
NOVICE: Ladies	3 min.	May <u>not</u> have passed higher than the Novice Free Skate Test. (Rule 4220)
Men	3 min. 30 sec.	
JUNIOR: Ladies	3 min. 30 sec.	May <u>not</u> have passed higher than the Junior Free Skate Test. (Rule 4210)
Men	4 min.	
SENIOR: Ladies	4 min.	Junior or Senior Free Skate Test. (Rule 4200)

COMPULSORY MOVES

There is no limit to the number of skaters a high school team may enter in this event. No Test Beginner through Pre-Juvenile will present a program without music no longer than the specified times. All compulsory moves will be skated on ½ ice surface. Elements may be skated in any order, and deductions will be taken for additional elements. Test requirements are the same as for Free Skate events. Ladies and Men may be combined at the discretion of the referee, depending upon number of entries.

PRE-JUVENILE	1 min 15 sec.	1. Axel Jump 2. Camel Spin (min. 3 revolutions) 3. Lutz/loop combination jump, with no steps or turns between jumps 4. Front to back scratch spin, exit on spinning foot (min. 4 revolutions on each foot) 5. Footwork sequence-straight line or diagonal.

SHORT PROGRAMS

To be Skated on full ice surface to music of skater's choice. Juvenile and Open Juvenile may be combined at the discretion of the referee depending on number of entries. Ladies and Men may be combined at the discretion of the referee depending upon number of entries.

ARTISTIC SHOWCASE

There is no limit to the number of skaters a high school team may enter in this event.

1. *Skaters will have prepared a program with music of their choice. Vocal music is permitted.*
2. *There are no required elements in this event. Skaters will be judged on originality, musical and artistic expression, audience appeal, choreography and costume.*
3. *The individual event durations are maximum times and are based on the National Showcase time guidelines which may vary significantly with other area competition.*
4. *Thirty seconds will be allowed before each performance for placement of props. The referee may disallow props that are deemed dangerous to the skater (eg sharp objects, feathers, dangling beads, loose paper, and items that may affect the conditions of the ice.)*
5. *Technical elements will be judged only on their appropriateness to the music.*
6. *Guest judges may be used for this event.*
7. *Skaters may not compete below their US Figure Skating freeskate test level but may skate up one level higher.*

In the interest of running an event, test levels may be combined if entry numbers are low.

Skaters placing fourth and higher in Preliminary and higher artistic/showcase solo events including adult events, may be qualified to enter the next National Showcase. For more information, contact Melissa Bowman, National Vice Chair for National Showcase at patinage_tx@verizon.net

TEAM SPIN AND MANEUVER TEAM EVENTS

1. There will be two groups for each of these two events. Low (US Figure Skating Juvenile freeskate and below) and High (US Figure Skating Intermediate freeskate and above).
2. A HSAC team may enter in both high and low groups as long as they are able to field at least two competitors on each team. A competitor may not skate in both levels. For example, a competitor may compete on both Low Spin and Low Maneuver Teams but they may not compete on both Low Spin and High Spin Teams. The HSAC must identify in advance who will compete in each group.
3. Each team will select 2 – 4 skaters to compete the 4 elements for each spin or maneuver team event.
4. Each team member may compete up to 2 elements in the spin event and the maneuver team event. If possible, teams with more than 4 skaters should select a different group of skaters for the spin event than those chosen to compete the maneuver event to allow more skaters to participate.

TEAM SPIN EVENT

Introductory steps (no more than 7) leading into spins will be permitted.

That's Entertainment – Group Event

We are offering two additional group events this year at the 2011 OHHS competition. The emphasis of both group events will be on the entertainment value rather than technical content. Elements to be considered in judging will be illustration of character, music interpretation, costuming, and audience appeal.

There will be two different group events: **Mini Production Ensemble** and **Production Ensemble**.

Overall Requirements

- Teams may enter either the Mini Production or Production Ensemble but not both.
- A maximum of one group may represent each school.
- All levels of skaters may participate in the number
- Music with vocals allowed
- Props allowed but must be carried on and off ice by skaters taking no more than 1 (one) minute to set up. No flame or smoke, wet mops, whipped or shaving cream, or any substance that may alter the ice in any way. No cap guns or loud noises.

Mini Production Ensemble Requirements

- A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 7 skaters may participate in the group number
- Maximum music time 3:10 minutes

Production Ensemble Requirements

- A minimum of 8 skaters may participate in the group number
- Maximum music time 6:40 minutes

These production ensemble events will be counted toward the final team point scores for 2012.

However, they will be considered extra events and will not count as a third event for the individual skaters. Each skater will be permitted to enter 3 other events.
