## **OFFICIAL ICE ARENA**

The U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships will be held at Hoover Arena, 15381 Royalton Road, Strongsville, OH (440.268.2800). This facility, which opened in 2002, has two NHL-sized ice surfaces. Both rinks are 85' x 200' with rounded corners and will be used for competition, practice ice and warm-ups. IceLand features 13 full-size locker rooms, a pro shop, a full service café and a video arcade. Additional unofficial practice ice will be offered offsite at the Michael A. Ries Ice Rink, Parma, Ohio.

Skaters' and coaches' e-mail addresses must be included and clearly written on the Intent to Compete form.

## **U.S. FIGURE SKATING RULES/CONDUCT/ELIGIBILITY**

The 2010 U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships will be conducted in accordance with the applicable rules of U. S. Figure Skating as set forth in the 2010 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook. The top competitors (based on the proportional plan) in **intermediate** and **juvenile** singles events at each regional championship shall be permitted to enter the comparable event at the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships (Rule 3141). Two alternates per event shall be designated in accordance with Rule 3170. The procedure outlined in Rule 3144 shall apply when there are fewer than four entrants in the applicable regional event.

The eight highest-placing teams in each division (**i.e. juvenile pairs, juvenile dance, intermediate pairs, intermediate dance**) at each sectional championship will advance to the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships (Rule 3142).

The international judging system (IJS) will be used, and marks will be posted in a designated area of the arena. The "Eligibility to Compete Requirements" in Rules 3030 and 3210 will apply.

Qualifying rounds and seeding for the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships will be conducted in accordance with Rule 3280 in the 2010 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook.

## **PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET**

*All competitors entering into the 2010 qualifying competition season are required as part of their online registration to submit a planned program content sheet (PPCS) detailing the elements in their program(s). You may update your PPCS at [www.usfsaonline.org](http://www.usfsaonline.org) up to one week prior to the start of your competition.*

## **LIABILITY**

*According to Rule 3222, U.S. Figure Skating and the clubs or organizers of the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skaters or officials. As a condition of and in consideration of the acceptance of entries and participation therein, all entrants, their parents and guardians, and officials shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks of injury to their person and property resulting from, caused by or connected with the conduct and management of the competition, and to waive and release any and all claims which they may have against any officials, U.S. Figure Skating, the Greater Cleveland Council of FSC, and against its officers, and their entries shall be accepted only on such condition.*

## **SPORTS ACCIDENT INSURANCE POLICY**

The U.S. Figure Skating Basic Sports Accident Insurance Policy covers all members of U.S. Figure Skating, including club members and Basic Skills Program members while participating in a duly sanctioned competition or club practice sponsored and supervised by the U.S. Figure Skating and/or their member clubs or Basic Skills programs.

The following is covered under the Basic Sports Accident Insurance Policy:

- Injuries that occur at practices and competitions sanctioned or sponsored, and supervised by U.S. Figure Skating. Coverage is provided to the limits of the policy for medical/dental expenses and death/dismemberment as a result of a qualifying injury that occurs during an accident.
- Sickness is *not covered*.
- Re-injury is considered a pre-existing condition. Potentially chronic injuries will be examined carefully as they have a tendency to recur.
- Chiropractic and physical therapy care will be limited.

## MUSIC

**Your music will be retained at your regional (singles) and sectional championships (pairs and dance) and forwarded to the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships.**

### **COMPETITION MUSIC INFORMATION (Required component of online registration)**

U.S. Figure Skating requires all competitors to fully complete a competition music information form as part of the online registration process.

The following information is required for each piece of music used in the composition of the short program/original dance and free skate/free dance: composer, orchestra, duration of music, record label/number (optional but highly recommended if obtainable).

### **COMPACT DISCS (CDs)**

For all qualifying events during the 2010 season, including the 2010 U.S. Junior Championships, CDs are the only acceptable media. CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. **Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. In the case of a short program and free program, two (2) separate discs must be used.** Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Lead-in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds.

### **New for 2010**

Each CD must be in a paper CD sleeve with a see through window (obtainable at any office supply store), also labeled with the skater's name and event. Standard hard plastic jewel cases or other CD holders are no longer acceptable. CDs that are not properly identified will NOT be accepted. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons, music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration. At the championships, competitors will not receive their credentials at registration until they turn in their music. The originals used at the regional championships will be forwarded to the sectional championships and the U.S. Junior Championships for those advancing. Those qualifying from the sectional championships will have their original music forwarded on to the U.S. Junior Championships/U.S. Championships.

CDs are to be mailed in "CD mailers," which can be obtained at the post office or any office supply store.

All competitors must have at least one (1) additional copy rinkside at practice sessions and during the actual competition event. The LOC will accept no responsibility for damage or loss.

U.S. Figure Skating will supply current dance music for compulsory dances.

All music may be picked up at the registration desk in the arena following each competitor's last event.

## SELECTION OF DANCES

*The compulsory dances to be skated in the 2010 U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships are:*

Intermediate: Foxtrot and American Waltz

Juvenile: Hickory Hoedown and Fourteenstep

## **EVENT CHECK IN AT HOOVER ARENA**

Competitors are required to check-in with the ice monitor one hour prior to the scheduled time of their event.

## **PRACTICE ICE**

### **OFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE:**

Official practice ice will begin in the morning on Tuesday, Dec. 15. Sessions will be 30 minutes in length.

Each competitor's music **will** be played on official practice ice. The official practice sessions are free of charge. Each competitor will be guaranteed one official practice for the following:

Qualifying Round Competitors: (Singles: Free Skate)  
Final Round Competitors ONLY: (Singles – Intermediate Short Program and Juvenile Free Skate, Pairs – Free Skate, Dance - Compulsory Dance, Free Dance)

### **WARM-UP ICE:**

20-minute warm-ups will be held for all rounds (qualifying and finals). No music will be played on warm up ice.

### **UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE**

Unofficial practice ice will be available throughout the competition at Hoover Arena and off site at the Michael A. Ries Ice Rink. Directions will be provided at the time of registration. Practice ice will start on Monday, Dec. 14 at Hoover Arena and Wednesday at the Michael A. Ries Ice Rink. Ice may be purchased in advance for Monday and Tuesday only. Pairs/dance only may purchase ice for Wednesday. Every effort will be made to have music played on unofficial practice ice sessions. Additional practice ice can be purchased at the registration desk. Sessions will be 30 minutes in length

## **REGISTRATION**

The official registration desk will be located at Hoover Arena and will open at 9 a.m. on Monday, Dec 14, 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled practice each day thereafter and will remain open one hour following a competition event.

## **OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD AND NOTICES**

Prior to the competition, updates and information will be posted on the Greater Cleveland Council of Figure Skating Clubs web site, [www.clevelandskating.com](http://www.clevelandskating.com).

The official bulletin board will be located in the Hoover Arena lobby. Any changes to the schedule will be posted and will prevail over other schedules. Competitors and coaches are responsible for checking the official bulletin board for current information and revisions.

## **CREDENTIALS**

Each competitor, one official coach per entry and one parent/chaperone per competitor will be provided a complimentary credential that allows access to the arena.

**Additional coach credentials may be purchased in accordance with the additional coach policies.**

Please make sure all appropriate names appear on the entry form. Passes are not to be used by anyone other than the person to whom they are issued. Any abuse of credentials will result in the offender's forfeiture of their pass.

Lost credentials will be replaced for a fee of \$50.

All coaches must comply with the coaches' registration policy in order to be allowed to instruct/coach at all qualifying competitions. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show proof of registration plus membership in both U.S. Figure Skating and PSA in order to receive a credential. Each local organizing committee (LOC) will ask to see each coach's registration, membership cards and a photo ID at check in. If they have not registered, they will not be allowed a credential – no exceptions.

## **MEDICAL SERVICES**

Qualified medical personnel will be available during the competition beginning Monday, Dec. 14.

## **AWARDS**

Medals will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place in the "Championship Final Rounds." There will be no awards following the qualifying rounds. All awards will be presented on ice on Saturday evening following the final event. Competitors should wear skating costumes and skates. Specific awards schedules will be posted on the official bulletin at Hoover Arena.

## **PROGRAM AND PUBLICITY PHOTOGRAPHS**

If you wish to have your photo included in the program, each singles competitor, pairs team and dance team must submit **one** photograph with their "Intent To Compete" form. The photo for the program book should be a standard vertical photograph (5x7"), black and white, headshot only. The reverse side of the photograph must be clearly labeled **with competitor's name(s), event and placement at skater's specific 2010 regional or sectional championships, coach(es)' and choreographer's names, and home club.**

**\*\*Preferred Method:** You may e-mail a photo to [smrego@aol.com](mailto:smrego@aol.com) (must be .jpg format, 300 dpi). E-mail message must include **competitor's name(s), event and placement at skater's specific 2010 regional or sectional championships, coach(es)' and choreographer's names, and home club.**

## **OFFICIAL DRAW**

The draw for initial rounds will be held in the balcony area of the Gallery at Hoover Arena Tuesday, Dec. 15 from 12:30-3:30 p.m. The schedule for the draw party will be posted on the GCCFSC web site and on the official bulletin board.

Skaters will be seeded into qualifying round groups (singles) by the chief referee based upon their placements at the regional championships. According to Rules 3330 and 3360, at the draw each skater will draw his or her own skating order within each designated qualifying round group. Subsequent draws will occur at the Hoover Arena upon posting of qualifying events' results and again after results are posted for the first segment of a final round event. Draws will be open, and skaters may draw their own number.

Pairs and dance will draw skating order for first segment of the championship rounds. (No qualifying rounds will be held).

## **COMPETITORS' PARTY**

After a hard week of practice and competition, join the other competitors for a relaxed evening of fun!

The competitors' party will be held Saturday, Dec. 19 at the Holiday Inn Select. The party is scheduled from 8 p.m.-12 a.m. and will include a DJ and refreshments. Additional information will be available on the Greater Cleveland web site, [www.clevelandskating.com](http://www.clevelandskating.com), and on the official bulletin board at Hoover Arena.

Each competitor will receive a complimentary ticket. Additional tickets are \$10.

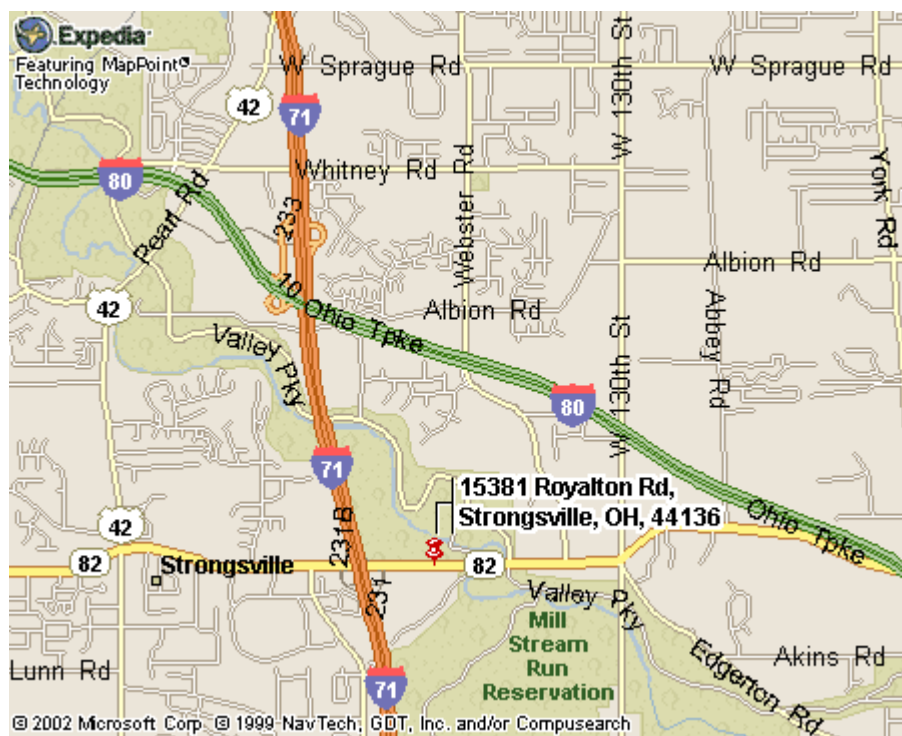


## Driving Directions

**From Cleveland Hopkins and points North:** Take I-71 South to the OH-82 E/N. Royalton exit, exit #231A. Merge onto Royalton Rd./OH-82. Stay in right lane. Rink is behind the Super 8 on south (right) side of the road just past the Holiday Inn.

**From I-71 South:** Take I-71 to the OH-82/N. Royalton exit, exit #231, towards Strongsville. Turn right onto Royalton Rd. Stay in right lane. Rink is behind the Super 8 on south (right) side of the road just past the Holiday Inn.

**From I-480:** Take I-480 East or West to Exit 11 towards I-71 S/Columbus, merge onto I-71. Take the OH-82 E/N. Royalton exit, exit #231 A. Merge onto Royalton Rd./OH-82. Stay in right lane. Rink is behind the Super 8 on south (right) side of the road just past the Holiday Inn.

## **2010 U.S. JUNIOR FIGURE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS COACHING POLICY**

In a continuing effort to minimize congestion, ensure each skater's safety and promote an environment in which our skaters are able to focus on a peak performance, U.S. Figure Skating is implementing the following credential and rink-side access policy in conjunction with the LOC. It is hoped that by reducing the distractions and congestion, the skaters, coaches and LOC will all benefit. This policy is for the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships.

1. Only legitimate coaches will be awarded coaching credentials for the U.S. Junior Championships.
  - a. Must be coaching member of U.S. Figure Skating and PSA
  - b. Must be an active coach that works with the skater who has qualified for the U.S. Junior Figure Skating Championships
2. Each singles entry may designate a maximum of two coaches for rink-side (entry/exit/staging) credentials. Each pair and dance team entry may designate a maximum of three coaches for rink-side credentials. One credential is free. The second and third must be purchased (\$50). No additional coaches are entitled to credentials.
3. Only two coaches for each singles entry and three coaches for each pairs/dance team will be allowed in the rink-side area. Due to space limitations, no exceptions will be made to this rule.
4. The skater(s) or the skater's parent is/are solely responsible for the designation of their coaches. Only the skater may change the designation of coaches. Changes may only be made one time and only at registration.
5. Credentials will be extended to coaches who require access to the lower levels of the arena if the situation warrants (awards, exhibitions, etc.).
6. Each skater is allowed an unlimited number of coaches at all practice sessions but each coach must have received or purchased the appropriate credential in accordance with items 1 and 2 on this page.
