Skaters MAY NOT take the ice if installment payments are not received by these dates.**

I hereby understand that by signing this application I consent to contract ice with the Strongsville Skating club for the upcoming season as wither a Home club or Associate Member. I acknowledge that when contracting ice: it is through The Strongsville Skating Club for the period designated, that a non-refundable Club Membership Fee and one-quarter (1/4) contracted ice payment must accompany this contract, that the full amount of the contract must be paid to The Strongsville Skating club, as specified in the Ice rules unless part or the entire contract is canceled. In the event that I wish to cancel any part or all of the contracted ice, I must inform the 1)Ice & Membership Chairman or 2) President in writing within seven (7) days prior to the desired date of cancellation. Failure to contact one or both for the designated individuals within the prescribed time frame means that the contract remains in effect for the designated period and that I owe the complete amount contracted.

In consideration of my participation in any Strongsville Skating Club program or Basic Skills activity, I acknowledge that I understand the nature of the activity and that I, and/or my minor child, am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I acknowledge that if conditions are unsafe, I, and/or my minor child, will immediately discontinue participation in the activity I fully understand that skating involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death, and that these and other risks may be caused by me, or my minor child's own actions, or inactions, those of others participation in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the Releasees named below, and that there may be other risks not known to me or not foreseen at this time, and I fully accept and assume all such risks and responsibility for losses, costs, and I hereby release, discharge, and covenants not to sue the Strongsville Skating Club, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, and any sponsors and advertisers of any event in which I participate (each considered one of the Releasees herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees. If I, or anyone on my and/or minor child's behalf, makes a claim which does not arise from gross negligence or, intentional, willful or wanton misconduct of Releasees against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, defend, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such claim. A \$20.00 processing fee for each session will be assessed for any contracted ice cancelled before the end of the skating period. A \$30.00 processing fee will be assessed for checks returned for non-sufficient funds. A \$25.00 late fee may be charged for ice payments received after the designated due date. NO REFUNDS. Credit will be given at the discretion of the SSC Board. Walk on fees will be charged to any skater whose bill is past due. Skaters will pay walk-on rate in addition to the contract installment if not paid on time.
