

Cleveland Championships 2000 and Beyond Fund 2006-2007 Guidelines and Application

History

The Cleveland Championships 2000 and Beyond Fund (the “Fund”) is an asset of Cleveland Championships 2000 (“CC 2000”), an Ohio nonprofit corporation that is tax exempt pursuant to Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Fund was established by CC 2000 to provide financial support to valuable projects in the amateur figure skating community. The goal of the Fund is to provide small financial grants to programs or projects that will advance the mission of CC 2000 and meet the purposes of the Fund.

Eligibility

Any individual, club, organization, or institution that has an amateur figure skating program or project needing financial support. The program must support amateur figure skating in the Greater Cleveland area. No grants will be given retroactively.

Application Procedure

- The due dates are:
 - Group** Application – November 1, 2006, February 1, 2007 and April 1, 2007
 - Individual** Application – February 1, 2007
- Typed applications are preferred over hand-written applications.
- Write a proposal outlining your program and addressing the following topics:
 - 1) General description of the program
 - 2) Benefits of the program
 - 3) Number of skaters served by the program
 - 4) Budget for the program
 - 5) Other sources of funding
 - 6) How the program will be continued after the first year
 - 7) Evaluation for the program
 - 8) Letters of support, if applicable
- Applications that do not follow the cover page or proposals that are missing questions, statements or pages will not be accepted.
- Your completed **Application** must consist of the items listed below.
3 packets (1 original and 2 copies) must be collated and stapled in the following order:
 - Application Form – first page signed
 - Proposal (group application)
 - Letters of support, if applicable
 - Signed letter of good standing from home club
- Conditions under which an application WILL NOT be accepted:
 - Any application returned by FAX or E-mail.
 - Any application reproduced (by computer) incorrectly or incompletely.
 - Any application packet that does NOT have 3 collated copies of all materials.
- Return one original and two collated copies of the application and proposal to:
